

The Red Rocket Billycart was built by David Peters in 2006 for the first Victorian billycart Championships held in Pyalong that year.

The Billycart is constructed from 2x60 litre paint drums with a steel tube outer frame. The rear wheels are 12" bicycle wheels attached to the outer steel frame, brakes are bicycle brakes on both back wheels which are applied via brake handles on the steering handlebars.

The front of the Billycart is the front section of a 20" BMX bicycle which is welded to the outer tube frame, There is another bicycle gooseneck mounted behind the windshield which mounts the steering handlebars and a link arm connects these to the front forks to finish the steering mechanism.

This Billycart was professionally built, is stable at speed brakes, well and has generated enormous interest at every event it has attended.
